With Round Up and the NHEC Foundation, Your Small Change Makes a Big Difference

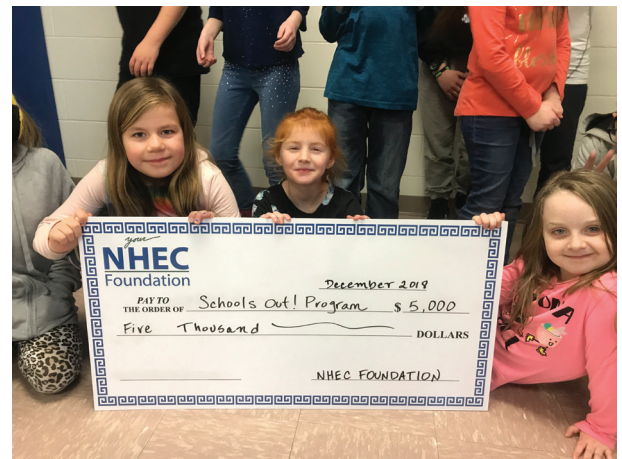
The NHEC Foundation has awarded \$3.5 million to non-profit organizations and community initiatives throughout Co-op service territory since 2006 and the impact has been huge. The engine that drives that success is the Round Up Program and the generosity of NHEC members.

What Is Round Up?

When you enroll in NHEC's Round Up Program, your electric bill is rounded up to the next dollar each month. The extra change is set aside in a Round Up fund, which enables the NHEC Foundation to award grants. Your contribution is tax-deductible and the maximum possible contribution is 99 cents per month, though the average member contributes about six dollars per year. Currently, more than 43,000 members are enrolled. Grants are awarded to non-profit, organizations throughout the year and include health and social service programs, education and enrichment programs and scholarships for our members and their children through the NHEC Foundation Scholarship Program.

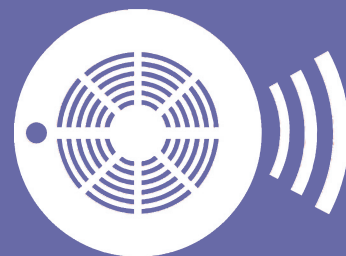

Make your appointment for FREE installation of smoke alarms

A \$7,500 grant from the NH Electric Co-op Foundation will help the American Red Cross of New Hampshire & Vermont install smoke alarms in the homes of Co-op members living in the city of Claremont.



The Red Cross Home Fire Preparedness Campaign is working to target homes that do not have smoke alarms. In partnership with the Red Cross, volunteers from NHEC will be hitting the road in the city of Claremont on October 26, 2019 to install alarms in the homes of our members who do not have functioning smoke alarms.

Please note – any home in New Hampshire without functioning smoke alarms can sign up for free installations. You do not have to be a resident of Claremont to have free alarms installed.
